



Modernizing APRN Practice in Indiana

What does Modernizing APRN practice DO?

- Changes protected title from Advanced Practice Nurse to the title endorsed by the Consensus Model and adopted by 47 other states- Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN)
- Increases access to care by removing the mandated regulatory barrier of collaboration agreement as a condition of APRN practice
- Improves health care efficiency and streamlines care when unnecessary administrative processes are removed through the retirement of the collaborative practice agreement
- Aligns with recommendations from the APRN Consensus Model by: requiring postgraduate education, and certification/or equivalence for prescriptive authority as a condition of APRN practice

What does Modernizing APRN practice NOT DO?

- Does NOT expand “scope of practice” of APRN
- Does NOT increase patient risk
- Does NOT reduce patient safety
- Does NOT increase healthcare costs
- Does NOT interfere with inter-professional collaboration or team-based care
- Does NOT jeopardize other health care providers position in healthcare
